

UNIVERSITY LIBRARIES

With more than 1.6 million volumes and over 4,000 periodical subscriptions, library collections support the subject areas in the curricula of the colleges and the research interests of over 1,000 faculties. The William S. Carlson Library is the main library for The University of Toledo. Other libraries include the Learning Resource Center (LRC) located at the Scott Park Campus, and the Law Library located within the College of Law on the Bancroft campus.

UTMOST is the online catalog providing access and locations of materials in all UT libraries. The University of Toledo is a charter member of OhioLINK, a statewide library and information network which links collections in academic libraries in the state.

UTMOST provides seamless access to a variety of online databases, full text journals, and full textbooks. Reference librarians are available to assist users in selecting appropriate databases for research.
