Scholarship Terms and Conditions for the International Rocket Award for students under the Zhejiang University of Finance and Economics (ZUFE) Program

- The awarded scholarship begins in the semester the student is accepted. Students must be enrolled and attend on a full-time basis two out of the three semesters the award is used. The award must be used for consecutive semesters.
- 2. The maximum length of this scholarship is three (3) semesters, not to exceed one academic year or the completion of a baccalaureate degree, whichever comes first.
- 3. One-half of the yearly award will be applied to the student's bill each semester to pay for the out-of-state surcharge (up to 18 credit hours per semester). This award is subject to the availability of funds and is not refundable. The scholarship will be pro-rated during the semester the student is attending less than full-time.
- 4. This scholarship will be used toward the payment of costs incurred at The University of Toledo and is not transferable to any other college or university.
- 5. Additional awards of other scholarships, grants or benefits may reduce the amount of this scholarship.
- 6. Please note the amount and continuation of your scholarship is subject to change. If any such changes are necessary, you will be notified in writing via your UToledo email address.
- 7. Academic year requirements for scholarship recipients enrolled in degree programs that require a mandatory co-op or internship experience will be adjusted as needed. Students will need to contact the Scholarship Office at Financialaidscholarship@utoledo.edu.
- 8. This award is limited to full time, non-immigrant, F-1 visa holders only.
