- 99% of our academic program and service unit plans are published. (287 of 291)

Assessment Reports

- 97% submission rate for the 2014-2015 academic program and service unit reports (282 of 291)
- 90% submission rate for the 2014-2015 general education reports (81 of 90)

A More Meaningful Process

Because most are now engaged in the process by providing data, we can do more...

"The UAC should shift from intensive effort at ensuring compliance on departmental reports to more focus on aggregating data across the institution and recommending actions. " (Barbara Walvoord consultation report, Spring 2014)

A New University Assessment Plan

Developed last spring, approved by the University Assessment Committee in August 2015

Includes new language in the UAC's Charge

"Review assessment information aggregated from multiple sources and make recommendations that inform institution's decision-making, strategic planning, and budgeting processes." (University Assessment Plan, 2015, p. 25)

Academic Program Report

General Education Report

Service Unit Report

Reviewing Data from Multiple Sources

UAC reviewed data from:
