The Executive Committee of Graduate Council meets during the summer. The focus of our work this summer was to prepare for the upcoming academic year.

An emphasis for Graduate Council this year will be to strengthen our partnerships. Kristen Keith and I have been working together to ensure communication and appropriate collaboration between Faculty Senate and Graduate Council. The first example of joint project is the development of an ad hoc committee on curriculum coordination to facilitate communication between Faculty Senate, Graduate Council, and the Office of the Provost.

On behalf of Graduate Council, I have had conversations with President Sharon Gaber and Board Chair Sharon Speyer.
