# **Pipeline Programs:**

## Since July 2017

- Collect information on existing programs
   (10+ programs, varied configurations, low enrollment)
- Reduce challenges improve workflow (admissions, financial aid, registrar, tracking)
- Develop a DRAFT template
   (4+1, 120+30 unique credits, 9 shared credits)
- Distribute template and collect feedback from potential pipeline programs



## **Next Steps:**

### **Spring 2018:**

- Meet with interested faculty
- Modify template as needed to address concerns (so far Math, Sociology, Engineering)
- Work with programs to establish new pipeline programs (MSPS/MS Law; BS/MS Social Work)
- Begin to fix existing pipelines (2018-2019)
- Advertise pipelines
