The goal of the National Black Prose Association's (NBPA) Job Fair is to promote diversity in prosecutors' offin providing a forum where law students, recent law graduates, and experienced att from across the nation can meet and interview with prospective prosec employers at the local, state, and federal levels.

The NBPA, established in 1983, is a professional member organization comprover 800 prosecutors. Our mission is to recruit, train, and advance the care minority attorneys as prosecutors at all levels of government. Our annual conviserves, not only as a job fair forum, but as a comprehensive legal training progr prosecutors. This year's 36th Annual Conference will run from July 14, 2019 to 20, 2019.
