

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
### **ENROLLMENT BY FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME**


For Fall Semester in Academic Year 2008 through 2017






### **OHIO STATE RESIDENCY AS A PERCENTAGE** OF ENROLLMENT BY STUDENT LEVEL













#### Assignable Square Feet by Major Function



#### **Assignable Square Feet by Campus and Major Function**



Main Campus Map




