The Ohio CBE Network serves as a forum for activities designed to bring Ohio faculty, staff and administrators together to learn about and share information related to CBE programming and discussing different topics (e.g., selecting technologies to support CBE programing, gaining ODHE, HLC and USDOE approval for CBE programs, partnering with business and industry on joint development of program competencies, projects and assessments). The Ohio CBE Network Steering Committee strives to create practical tools for colleges and universities interested in pursuing competency-based education to include a network of expert practitioners, and a repository of resources and best practices for CBE development, implementation, and sustainment.

Finish for Your Future (High Impact Strategies Sub-committee member)

Responsible for researching Ohio focused, high impact strategies for increasing adult learner enrollment and advancing improvement of adult learner outcomes. Research will include how Ohio Technical Centers (OTCs), colleges, and universities have determined, implemented, and measured their high impact strategies for adult learners and their plans for continuous improvement. Research will result in formulation of recommendations regarding high-impact practices that maximize:

- student success;
- workforce connections and alignment; and
- equity imperative for adult learners.

High-Impact practices subgroup will draft findings and report to inform the Adult Learner Working Group by April 2020.
