## (A) Policy statement

The University of Toledo awards credit hours based upon a two-semester academic calendar consisting at a minimum of thirty weeks. An academic semester consists of fifteen weeks of instruction, which includes one week for final examinations (UT-AAUP *CBA*).

In accordance with the Ohio Administrative Code, an academic year is a period of time that is at least thirty weeks in length exclusive of compressed terms (e.g. summer term). (OAC 3333-1-02 (B) (18)

## (B) Purpose of policy

The policy defines the academic calendar and the academic year.

## (C) Scope

The policy applies to both undergraduate and graduate programs of study at the University.

## (D) Procedure

A change to the duration of the semester academic calendar and/or the terms within an academic year requires approval by the board of trustees.
