## (A) Policy Statement

Patients with documented, life-threatening security concerns or who request to be confidential will be registered as "NIA".

## (B) Purpose of Policy

Circumstances may exist whereby it is necessary to safeguard a patient by using confidential status or when patients request to be confidential during his/her episode of care.

## (C) Procedure

- 1. The patient will be registered as an "NIA" patient type when the patient care unit and HSC Security agree that there is a life-threatening situation in which the patient's or staff's safety can be best protected by the use of confidential status or when the patient requests to be confidential.
- 2. Under no circumstance will the patient be given an alias name. As a confidential patient, no information will be given to callers. The facility will not acknowledge that the patient is present to any callers, including those claiming to be family members.
