(A) Policy Statement

(B) Purpose of Policy

All members of the Clinical Affairs Committee of the Board of Trustees will understand and fulfill their responsibilities.

(C) Procedure

- 1. The Chief Executive Officer, UTMC will be responsible for assuring that, on an annual basis, specific time is dedicated to updating Clinical Affairs Committee members of the Board of Trustees on the following topics:
 - a. Roles and Responsibilities
 - b. Quality Improvement
 - c. Risk Management/Safety Programs
 - d. Medical Staff Credentialing/Privilege Delineation Process
 - e. Patient Rights
 - f. Regulatory Agency Activities
 - g. Evaluation of the hospital's performance in relation to its mission, vision and goals.
- 3. Miscellaneous publications may be distributed by the Chief Executive Officer, UTMC on a periodic basis for review by members of the Clinical Affairs Committee.
- 4. Clinical Affairs Committee members are also encouraged to attend formal continuing education programs related to Hospital Governing Body roles and responsibilities and shall be made aware of such programs on an ongoing basis.
- 5. Other resources as appropriate will be made available by Hospital Administration to assure adequate ongoing orientation and training of all Clinical Affairs Committee members.
