(A) Policy Statement

Initial screening of all potential living kidney donors to determine appropriateness for donation.

(B) Purpose of Policy

To identify potential living kidney donors.

(C) Procedure

1. Interview with potential donor either in person or via telephone. All potential candidates will be considered until ruled out medically.

1. Contraindications to donation include but are not limited to:
 - a. Heart disease
 - b. Diabetes mellitus
 - c. Active cancer or incomplete treatment of malignancy
 - d. History of cancer is subject to further discussion by the donor surgeon and the kidney transplant committee
 - e. Kidney disease
 - f. Hypertension with treatment of two anti-hypertensives, uncontrolled HTN, or HTN with evidence of end stage organ damage
 - g. BMI: Body habitus will be taken into consideration at the discretion of the donor surgeon
 - Absolute contraindication: BMI of 40 and above
 - Relative contraindication: BMI of over 35 and up to 40-potential donor can be evaluated for donation. Approval of donor BMI will be determined on a case by case basis. The team will take into consideration the ESRD Risk Tool for Kidney
