## (A) Policy Statement

ASHP accredited residency programs must select individuals appropriately qualified to enter and complete a pharmacy residency curriculum.

## (B) Purpose of Policy

This policy will ensure fair and equitable selection of qualified pharmacists to enter into post-graduate training at The University of Toledo Medical Center.

## (C) Procedure

PGY1 Resident Eligibility: Applicants with the following qualifications are eligible for appointment to UTMC PGY1 pharmacy residency programs:

- PharmD degree from an ACPE Accredited University or FPGEC certification
- Eligible for licensure in Ohio

PGY2 Resident Eligibility: Applicants with the following qualifications are eligible for appointment to UTMC PGY2 pharmacy residency programs:

- Certificate of completion from an ASHP accredited PGY1 program
- PharmD degree from an ACPE Accredited University or FPGEC certification
- Eligible for licensure in Ohio

## **Resident Selection:**

- Residency Programs must select from among eligible applicants on the basis of residency programrelated criteria such as their preparedness, ability aptitude, academic credentials, communication skills
  and personal qualities such as motivation and integrity. The University of Toledo Medical Center and
  its Pharmacy Residency Programs will not discriminate with regard to sex, race, age, religion, color,
  national origin, disability, or any other applicable legally protected status. Performance in pharmacy
  school, personal letters of recommendation, achievements, humanistic qualities, and qualities thought
  important to the desired specialty will be used in the selection process.
- UTMC programs participate in the American Society of Health System Pharmacists (ASHP) Match via the Pharmacy Online Residency Centralized Application Service (PhORCAS) in selecting residents.
