## (A) Policy Statement

Facilities and procedures will be in place for the radiation protection of members of the public who are visitors to The University of Toledo Medical Center.

## (B) Purpose of Policy

To protect visitors from undue exposure to ionizing radiation.

## (C) Procedure

- 1. Areas where ionizing radiation may be present are restricted to use by employees and others necessary to providing care to patients.
- 2. Restricted areas are identified with signs or warning lights.
- 3. Rooms with doors to public areas may have interlocks that prevent radiation generation when they are open.
- 4. Radiation shielding is provided to limit the exposure of any member of the general public to less than 2 mR/week.
- 5. A radiation survey is performed for each new installation to verify that shielding is adequate.
