Start with any browser. Type IBC.utoledo.edu, in the address bar at the top of the browser. (Common Mistake: do no type into the google search bar in the middle of the screen). This will direct you to the login screen where you can log in with your UTAD credentials.



Upon log in you'll see your Dashboard. In this example John PI has 63 Active Studies at the top and 10 Xforms and 10 Open Events.
